Food chain/food web vocabulary

Producer – starts the food chain. Usually a green plant which can make its own food using photosynthesis

Consumer - eats the producer

Herbivore – eats plants

Carnivore – meat eater

Omnivore – eats both meat and plants

Prey – a creature which is eaten by another creature

Predator – a creature which eats another creature



This food chain shows a leaf is eaten by a worm, which is then eaten by a bird. The arrow means 'is eaten by'.

Habitat – a place where a creature lives

Vertebrates – have a back bone



Invertebrates - don't have a backbone



Adaptation – how each creature has changed to suit their habitat

Continent	A massive area of land that is separated from others by water or other natural features
Ocean	A huge area of salt water between continents
Sunlight zone	Top layer of ocean to 200m
Twilight zone	Next layer to 1000m
Midnight zone	From 1000m to 4000m
Abyss	4000m to 6000m
Trenches	6000m to 11000m
