

Childhood

Definition

- The time between infancy and adolescence

Characteristics

- Aged 2-13
- Normally live at home with parents



Examples

- Going to school.
- Playing with friends
- Eating lots of sweets!

Non Examples

- Being a grown up!
- Having a fulltime job

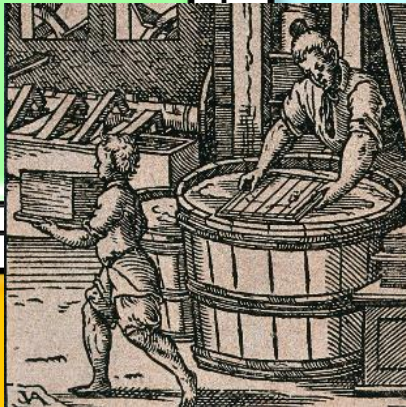
Apprentice

Definition

- A young person who learns a trade or occupation in return for accommodation, clothing and food

Characteristics

- Lasted for 7 years
- Learned from a master
- Only had Sundays off



Examples

- Butcher
- Glover
- Gong Farmer

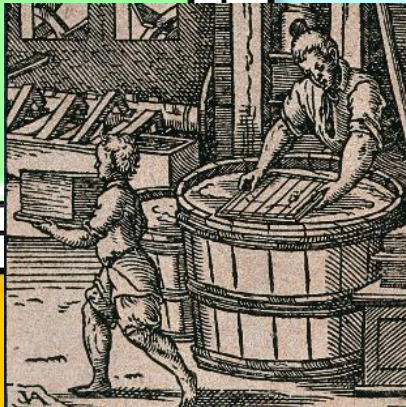
Non Examples

Master

Definition

- A skilled craftsman who takes on and teaches his trade to a young apprentice



Characteristics

- Must be good at his job
- Fed, clothed and housed the apprentice

Examples

- Butcher
- Glover
- Gong Farmer

Non Examples

- Apprentice

Primary Source

Definition

- An original document or object from the period being studied that has not been changed in any way

Characteristics

- Comes from a person who was involved in the events being studied.
- Some primary sources supply factual information

Examples

- Original artwork
- Photographs
- Letters
- Diaries

Non Examples

- Textbooks
- Dictionaries and encyclopedias
- Biographies



Secondary Source

Definition

- A document or a record that was not written at the time of the event studied

Characteristics

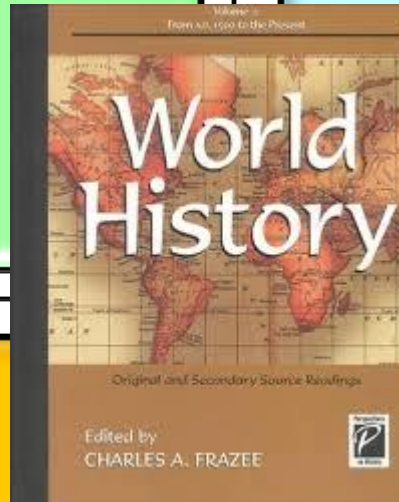
- Describe or explain primary sources.
- Tend to summarise and interpret

Examples

- Textbooks
- Dictionaries and encyclopedias
- Biographies

Non Examples

- Original artwork
- Photographs
- Letters
- Diaries



Government

Definition

- An organisation that runs a country and makes laws

Characteristics

- The government decides how taxes should be spent. E.g. on education, the police and the National Health Service



HM Government

A Matter of Trust

Examples

- UK Government led by the Prime Minister

Non Examples

- The School Council
- School Governors

Parliament

Definition

- Comprising the House of Commons, the House of Lords and the Monarchy

Characteristics

- The Parliament passes laws and checks the work of the Government



Examples

- House of Commons
- House of Lords
- The Monarch

Non Examples

- Horncastle Town Council

Poverty

Definition

- The state of having little money to pay for accommodation, food, heating or clothing.



Characteristics

- Living in poor housing conditions
- Not having enough to eat

Examples

- Victorian street children

Non Examples

- Princes and princesses

Leisure Time

Definition

- Free time spent relaxing, entertaining or enjoying hobbies



Characteristics

- Being with friends
- Doing something you enjoy
- Could be inside or outside

Examples

- Swimming
- Riding a bike
- Reading for pleasure
- Playing games

Non Examples

- Coming to school
- Working

Vaccination

Definition

- A substance given to a patient that prevents the development of a disease

Characteristics

- Given by a Dr or nurse
- Normally an injection

Examples

- Covid vaccination
- Flu nasal spray
- MMR

Non Examples

- Calpol
- Anti-biotics
- Penicillin
