Mammal

Definition

 An animal with a spine, fur and gives birth to live young

Characteristics

- Different types (monotremes, marsupials and placentals)
- Warm blooded

Examples

- Platypus
- Horse
- Bear
- Kangaroo
- Humans

- Snake
- Frog
- Beetle

Life Cycle

Definition

 A series of stages a living thing goes through



- Insects have a stage of metamorphosis
- Start with being born as live young or eggs



- Amphibian life cycle
- Bird life cycle
- Insect life cycle

- Remains a froglet
- Remains fledgling

Amphibian

Definition

 A cold-blooded vertebrate that lives on both land and water

Examples

- Frog
- Newt

Characteristics

 Have a portion of their lives underwater after hatching

- Eagle
- Lion
- Hamster

Metamorphosis

Definition

 A process by which the young form of insect or amphibian changes into adult form

Characteristics

 Amphibians and insects are the two main organisms that have this process within their life cycles

Examples

- Caterpillar into a butterfly
- Froglet into a frog

- Tadpoles hatching from frogspawn
- Bird hatching
- Growing up

Insect

Definition

 A small animal that has three body sections and doesn't have a back bone

Characteristics

- Have three body sections
- Have antenna
- Often have 6 legs

Examples

- Ants
- Butterfly
- Dragonfly

- Dog
- Cat
- Sunflower

Chrysalis

Definition

 A specific type of pupa that occurs in the life cycle of butterflies and moths

Characteristics

- Firm hard casing
- Important stage of metamorphosis
- Contains pupa/ insect inside

Examples

- Caterpillar Chrysalis
- Moth Chrysalis

- Tadpole
- Fledgling
- Child

Fledgling

Definition

 A young bird growing feathers and can leave the nest

Characteristics

- Has majority of it feathers developed
- If it's a flying bird it will be in the process of learning to take flight
- Dependent on mother

Examples

- Young chicken
- Young flamingo

- Panther
- Frog
- Adult bird

Tadpole

Definition

 A baby frog that has a long tail and no legs and lives under water

Characteristics

- Has a tail
- Has gills
- Has a mouth
- No legs

Examples

- Tree frog tadpole
- Dart frog tadpole

- Fish
- Snake
- Spider
